

Scheme Fair Processing Notice

Last updated 14 November 2017

The information contained in this notice (the “**Notice**”) is for the attention of holders of the 10.25% Senior Secured Notes due 2021 (the “**Notes**”) issued by Seven Energy Finance Limited (the “**Company**”) and any other individuals whose personal information may be provided to the Company, its parent, Seven Energy International Limited (the “**Parent**”), or to the Information Agent on behalf of the Company and SEIL, including through this website or otherwise as part of the proposed parallel schemes of arrangement in respect of the Notes (the “**Schemes**”). Such other individuals may include Noteholders’ custodians, other intermediaries, scheme participants and authorised representatives of these parties.

By providing personal information to the Company, the Parent, or the Information Agent (as defined below) on behalf of the Company or the Parent, through this website or otherwise as part of the Schemes, you are confirming that you are a beneficial owner of the Notes (a “**Noteholder**”), or acting on behalf of a Noteholder, and have sufficient authority to provide any such personal information you give to the Company or the Parent.

Collection of personal information

The Company, the Parent, or the Information Agent on their behalf, only collects personal information to the extent it is provided by you, including through the Information Agent, for example when you complete an accession letter in relation to the lock-up agreement, an account holder letter in relation to the Schemes or through any future communications between you and the Information Agent.

‘Personal information’ is any information that relates to an identified or identifiable individual.

The Company and the Parent only use personal information you provide as required in order for the Company to perform its obligations and exercise its rights in relation to the Schemes. This includes sharing this information with the Information Agent or the Parent (as the case may be) to administer the relationship between the Company and Noteholders and facilitating any payments to the Noteholders in accordance with the terms of the Schemes.

When the Company or the Parent handles any personal information you provide, it may rely on one of the following processing conditions to do so:

- **Performance of a contract:** this is when the processing of personal information you provide to it is necessary in order to perform its obligations under a contract;
- **Legal obligation:** this is when the Company or the Parent is required to process personal information you provide to it in order to comply with a legal obligation, such as keeping records for tax purposes or providing information to a public body or law enforcement agency; or
- **Legitimate interests:** the Company or the Parent may process personal information you provide to it where it is in its legitimate interest in running a lawful business to do so, provided such interests are not overridden by the relevant individuals’ rights.

Sharing of personal information

The Company or the Parent may share personal information you provide to it with:

- D.F. King Limited, the information agent engaged by the Company in the context of the Schemes (the “**Information Agent**”);
- The Company’s or the Parent’s legal and professional advisors;

- Certain groups of Noteholders and their professional and legal advisors; and
- Law enforcement agencies (including to regulators, courts, governmental bodies etc.).

Individuals' rights

If you have submitted personal information to us, the relevant individuals may benefit from certain rights, including the right to: (i) access or correct such personal information; and (ii) object to the Company's or the Parent's processing of such personal information.

The relevant individuals can make a request or exercise these rights by contacting the Parent at jack.coleman@sevenenergy.com, who will make reasonable efforts on the Company's or the Parent's behalf to comply with that request, so long as it is consistent with applicable law and professional standards.

Data retention

The Company or the Parent keeps personal information only for as long as it deems reasonably necessary for the purposes for which it was collected or to comply with any applicable internal, legal or regulatory reporting or document retention requirements.

Changes to this Notice

The Company or the Parent may modify this Notice from time to time. When we make changes to this statement, we will revise the "updated" date at the top of this page. We encourage you to periodically review this Notice to be informed of any such changes.
